## Our commitment to research in Latin America

The Parenteral Nutrition Research Grant Latin America 2018 was the next milestone in the "United for clinical nutrition" initiative by Fresenius Kabi. The grant was established as a consequence of the data from the Screening Day in 2016, identifying:

- The extent of malnutrition in critically ill hospitalized patients in Latin America
- The opportunities to improve patient outcomes through improved nutrition practices


The second wave of the Parenteral Nutrition Research Grant Latin America will be now an additional step in tackling the challenges revealed by the study:

- Supports you in providing solutions for malnourished critically ill patients in Latin America
- Stimulates thoughtful research in parenteral nutrition therapy
- Provides resources to enable further research to advocate adequate clinical nutrition

## Activities and research areas supported by the grant:


- Effective screening, treatment and monitoring
- Reduction of prevalence of nutritional deficits
- Metabolic effects of parenteral nutrition
- Evidence of improved patient outcomes
- Demonstration of health economic benefits
- Research collaboration within multidisciplinary teams
- Projects on innovative education approaches

## Who can apply?

- Post-graduate healthcare professionals based in hospitals in Latin America
- Investigators of the institutions must possess a medical doctor degree (or comparable academic degree) and have published in recognized academic journals
- Applications from interdisciplinary teams are appreciated

## When will the winner be announced?

All eligible applications will be reviewed by the Research Grant Committee, consisting of key opinion leaders in the field of clinical nutrition. The Committee will then decide the grant recipient.

### The recipient will be:

- Informed personally in June 2021, assuming the ethics committee approval has been provided
- Honored in a ceremony in July at the FELANPE 2021 congress in Ecuador

\* or equivalent in local currency to be issued in two parts, upon approval from the appropriate ethics committee.

\*\* proof of submission to ethics committee is sufficient for application, however approval must be complete by the time the grant is awarded.
